So far, not so many freelancers have legalized, what contradicts to the pilot project and what conditions do the self-employed people disagree with?</p> <p>Possible reasons for being in the "shadow":</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Is the legal activity expensive? ▪ Does entrepreneur’s registration entail high risks of interest from inspectors and law enforcement officers, as well as an increased amount of fines? ▪ “Shadow” is a generally accepted socially unsubstantiated state of the active population, it’s not clear to people what their taxes are used for? ▪ It is not clear for people why they should legalize and use a short-term amnesty? Thus, Russia might become one of the most developed and modern economies</p> <p>The main engine of the growth is a private-sector initiative, supported by active stimulation and soft monetary policy. The “Roadmap” on Sustainable Growth of the Non-Resource-Based Sector of the Russian economy has been elaborated.</p> <p>This “Roadmap” determines 9 key non-resource-based sectors of the Russian economy, which have the biggest potential and multiplier effect. What are the first steps of the transit from the passive economic policy toward the policy of growth?
